* LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR *

What an exciting time to be involved in BCSU! As I look back over the past year, I am incredibly grateful for the ways that God has led and cared for the students and staff of BCSU throughout Bulgaria! By His grace we have seen students grow as disciples of Christ, student groups grow in boldness in sharing their faith, and volunteers and staff grow in serving and leading.

Something I am truly thrilled about this year is the growth of our staff team. We received great support from you, our partners in ministry, to our appeal to give generously for a new BCSU staff worker. As a result, in September we were able to welcome Ivan Ivanov to our team; he is working to support and pioneer new student groups in central Bulgaria. I am proud of Ivan and our entire staff team who serve students tirelessly and with excellence each and every day! Their hard work, alongside of God's gracious leading and your prayers, is producing a harvest among students.

As you will see in the report below, we have a great deal to be grateful for in 2018! Looking back over the year, we see that though we have the same number of students involved in BCSU that we did last year at this time, over 40% of these students are new to our groups this fall. This means that we are seeing great growth in reaching new students. I am confident that this will only increase as we create witnessing groups in cities like Gabrovo and Shumen, where there is currently no active student groups. What is more a large percentage of these students are new to the faith. BCSU is playing an instrumental role in the lives of these young Christians as they are learning to take their first steps in following Jesus. I should also mention that we have seen a remarkable increase in our ministry to international students this year with two new groups in V. Turnovo and Varna. Most of these students are not yet followers of Jesus but God continues to give us many open doors to share our faith with them. What a great time to be a part of BCSU!

But it is even more special to be a part of BCSU at this moment because we are celebrating our 25th birthday this year. What a great testimony to God's love, mercy and faithfulness to students in Bulgaria that there has been a constant witness over these 25 years! As we look back, we can see God's faithful hand in providing for us and leading us; most joyfully we have seen the fruit of this ministry in lives of students and alumni who are impacted by Scripture, trained in leadership, and faithful in outreach!

Obviously, we are taking time to celebrate God's goodness and faithfulness to us over these years. And because you have certainly played a role in what God is doing in BCSU we want to invite you to celebrate with us. 


Student leadership days

As you can see throughout this report, we have much to give thanks for. Students have been reached with the good news of Jesus throughout the country. We would ask that you would continue to pray for BCSU as we enter this new year. Pray that the staff and student leaders would be sensitive to God's leading so that we could continue to faithfully and boldly share the good news and develop life-long disciples. Pray also that God would open up doors for witnessing communities among students in cities, like Gabrovo and Shumen, where there is currently no ministry among students.

Similarly, we ask that you would pray that God would provide for all of our financial needs. For this to happen we need to raise about 700 lev (\$400) per month in new support this year. We are completely confident that God is more than able to abundantly provide for these needs. If you are not giving already, might you consider partnering with us regularly in this ministry. If we were to find

- 2 people to give 100 lev (\$60) per month
- 5 people to give 50 lev (\$30) per month
- 10 people to give 25 lev (\$15) per month
